With gently smiling jaws!"*

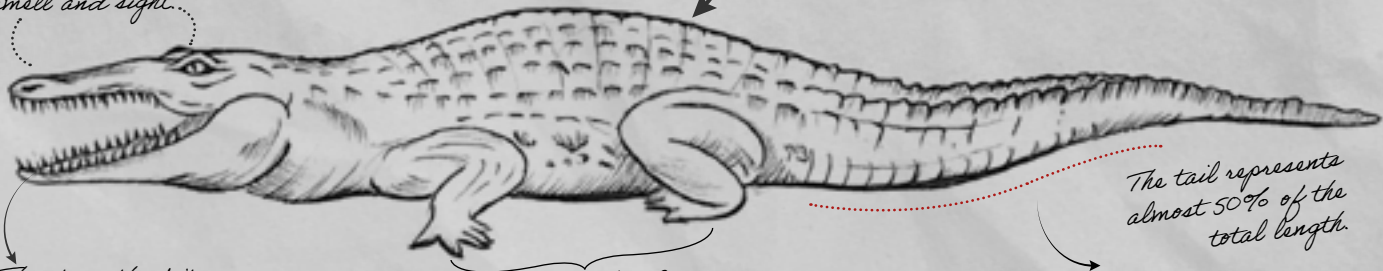
CROCODILE

Its most developed senses are smell and sight.

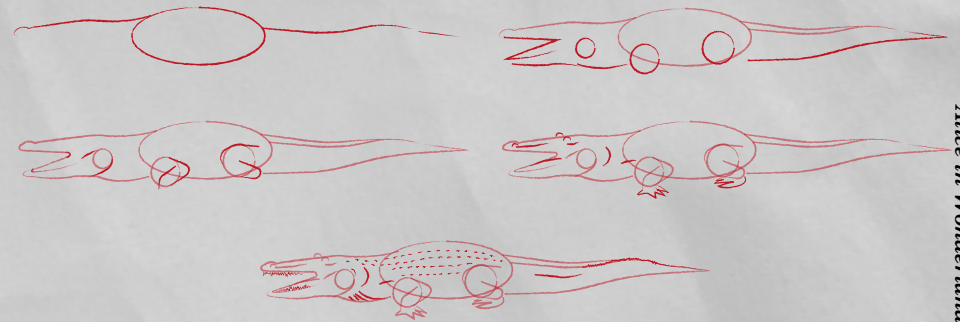


The strength of its bite is equivalent to 1800 Kg.

Short, strong and webbed legs.

The tail represents almost 50% of the total length.

LOBSTER



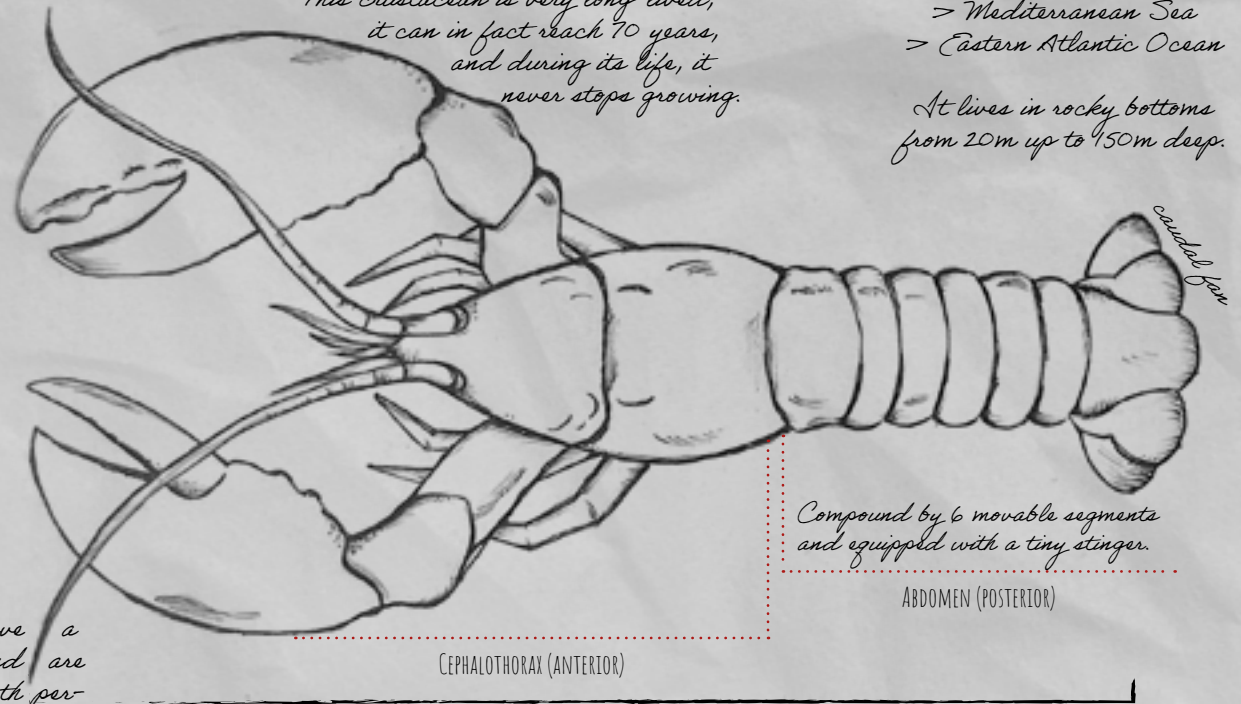
Curiosity

It lives in rocky bottoms from 20m up to 450m deep.

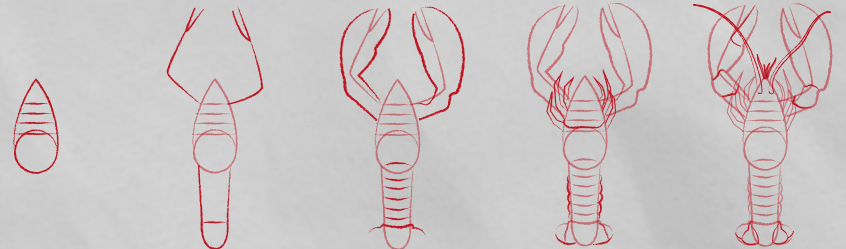


Compound by 6 movable segments and equipped with a tiny stinger.

They quite forgot their quarrel.*

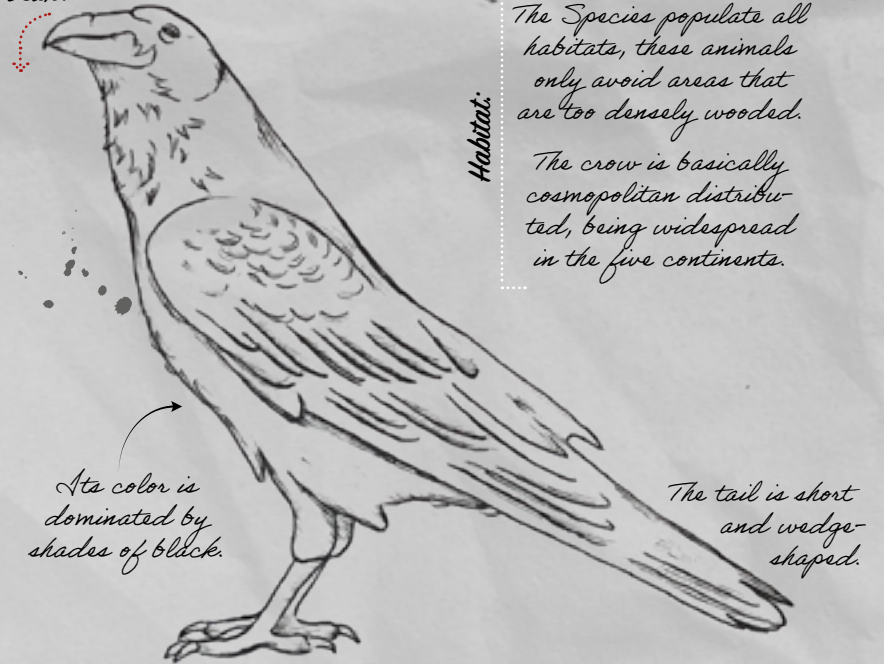
Curiosity

Strong conical, elongated and pointed beak.



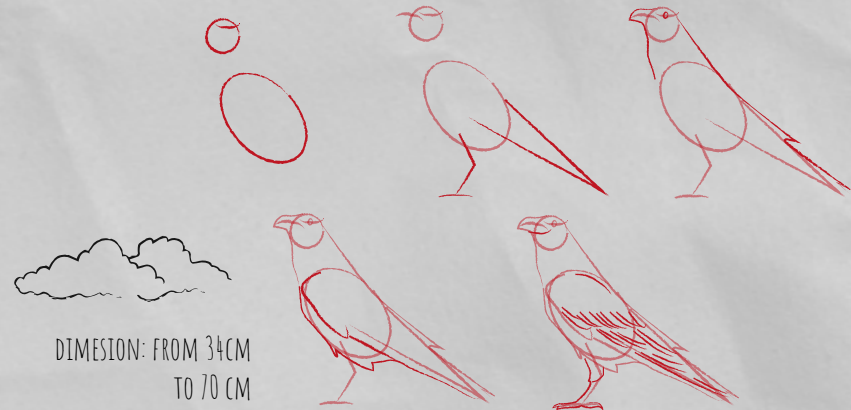
Habitat:

The Species populate all habitats, these animals only avoid areas that are too densely wooded.

The crow is basically cosmopolitan distributed, being widespread in the five continents.

Its color is dominated by shades of black.

The tail is short and wedge-shaped.

The mane intimidates enemies and protects it from bites.

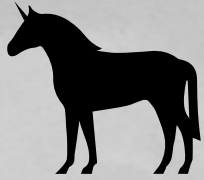


The tawny hair blends with the color of the grass of the Savannah.

Single long horn wrapped in a spiral on the forehead.



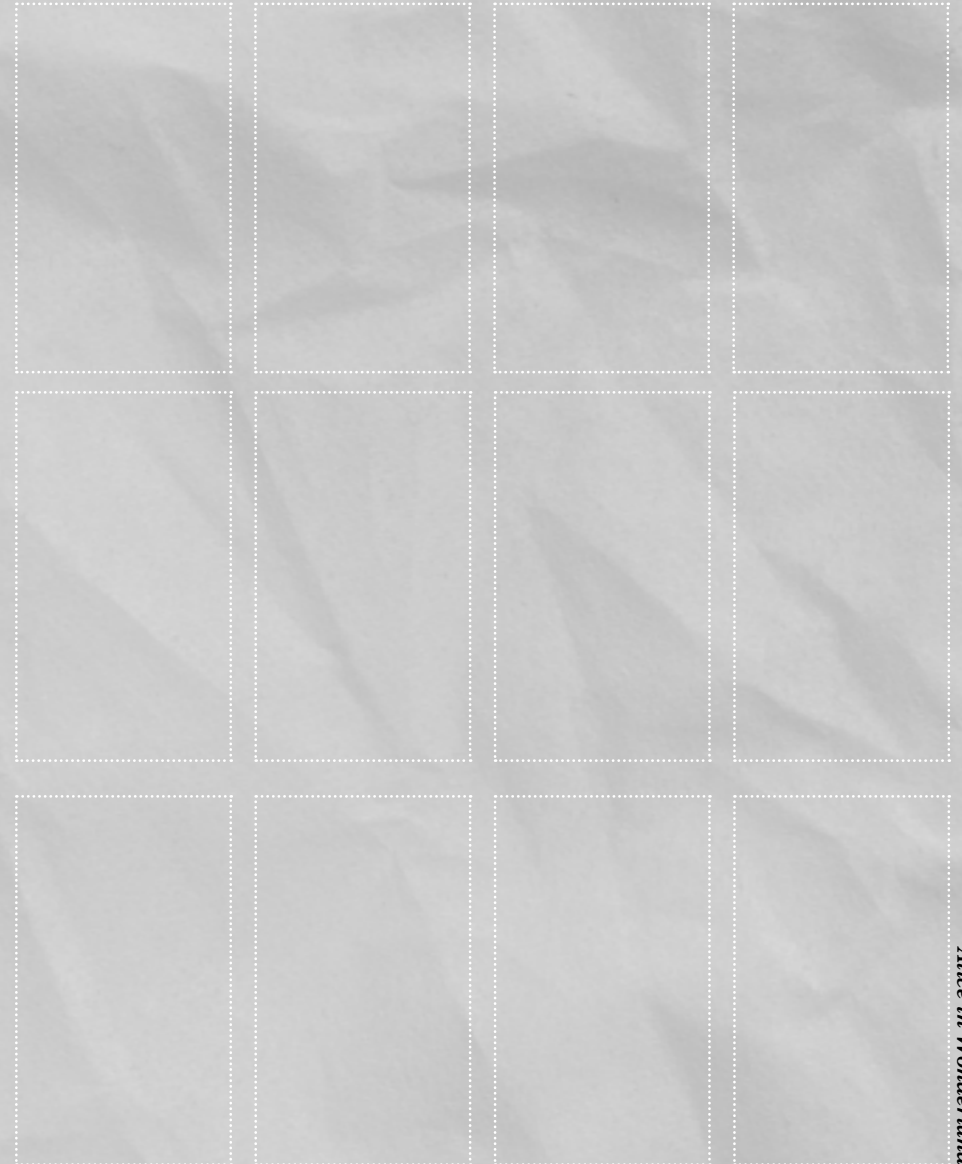
Typically pictured as a white horse endowed with magical powers.

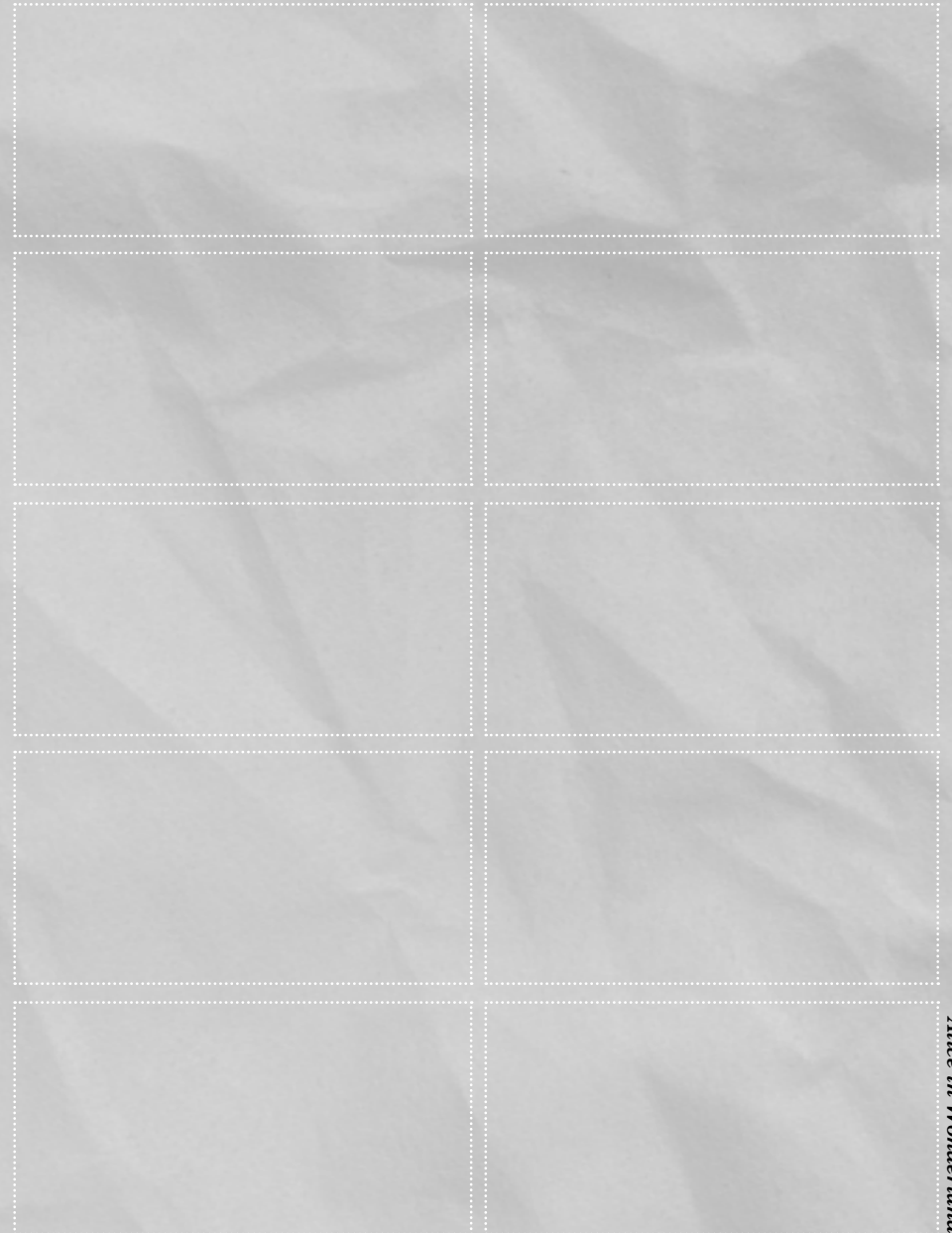
Drawing and experimenting inside your sketchbook is going to allow you to grow incredibly fast as an artist, but only if you are consistent.
